**NOTIFICATION**

**No.(G-III)RSU/SEMIS-ASC30/2020:-** In supersession of earlier notification NO.RSU/SEMIS/ASC/2014, dated 02<sup>nd</sup> Dec 2014 regarding guidelines of allotment of SEMIS code to existing schools without SEMIS Code has been revised on the recommendation of committee and after the approval of competent authority i.e. Minister for Education Sindh as under:-

- a. General Conditions:**
- The school without SEMIS Code should have been reported in any previous Annual School Census (ASC). If such school has not been reported in any Annual School Census, the concerned DSE/DEO may provide reasons to the SEMIS Allotment Committee for not reporting such school earlier.
  - The school should have minimum enrolment of 30 at primary level.
  - There should not be another government primary school of the same gender within the radius of 1.5 km, if the under consideration school is a primary level school without SEMIS Code.
  - There should not be another post-primary government girls school within the radius of 1.5 km, if the under consideration school is a post-primary level girls school without SEMIS Code.
  - There should not be another post-primary government boys school within the radius of 2 km, if the under consideration school is a post-primary level boys school without SEMIS Code.
  - The school without SEMIS Code, situated within the premises or very close (within 200 meters) to the existing functional SEMIS-School of the same gender may be considered for merger.
  - If there is existing functional school with SEMIS Code, a separate arrangement for higher level school of the same gender within the same premises will not be allotted new SEMIS code. The existing functional school with SEMIS Code may be considered for Up gradation to higher level.
- b. Conditions for Schools in Densely Populated Urban Areas**
- The condition of required radius may be relaxed, if the school without SEMIS Code has large enrolment and the students of such school cannot be accommodated in the nearby Government schools of the same gender.
- c. Conditions for Girls Primary Schools in Rural Areas**
- The condition of required radius may be relaxed to 1 km in case of girls' primary school in sparsely populated rural areas.
  - The condition of required enrolment may be reduced to 25 in case of girls' primary school in sparsely populated rural areas.
